Exam registration period	06 May – 30 May 2008
Eligibility Requirements	<p>UK candidate: Successful completion of the MRCP(UK) exam and/or enrolment in a UK higher training post in Gastroenterology</p> <p>Candidates in UK training posts first become eligible to sit the KBA in Gastroenterology after entering year 3 (ST3) but would usually take it at some point during ST4-6.</p> <p>Overseas candidate: Successful completion of the MRCP(UK) exam</p>
Qualification	<p>Certificate in Gastroenterology</p> <p>Upon successful completion of the CCT, trainees in UK higher training posts will be entitled to apply to the Federation of Royal Colleges of Physicians for MRCP(UK) Gastroenterology</p>
Syllabus	<p>The syllabus is published by the JRCPTB. http://www.jrcptb.org.uk/Specialty/Documents/Gastroenterology%20Specialty%20Training%20Curriculum%20May%202007.pdf</p>
